## Job Posting - Alpena Biorefinery Production Electrician

### POSITION SUMMARY:

This position provides electrical, instrumentation and controls support and also supports production shift operations. Alpena Biorefinery produces wood molasses for sale as animal feed pellet binder from the industrial effluent of the Decorative Panels International hardboard plant. The AB facility also provides traditional waste water treatment services for DPI producing clean, environmentally compliant effluent discharge into Lake Huron. Unit operations include evaporation, liquid and solids separations, mechanical aeration, flocculation, drying, and testing of in process materials.

### JOB DESCRIPTION AND DUTIES

Typical responsibilities will include:

- Provide both repair and routine electrical and controls systems maintenance
- Implement limited electrical and controls system changes to support plant improvement activities
- Operate biorefinery and effluent treatment plant equipment on a part time basis as a member of the day shift 7 day per week production crew
